(Diary, 699)

forgiveness of sins and punishment.

On that day, all the divine floodgates, through which graces flow, are open. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it human or angelic, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity.

Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy.

Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity."
