The fourth Sunday of Easter is a very special day. We are asked to pray for an increase of vocations to Priesthood and Religious Life. Vocations are and ought to be fostered in the community. It was Jesus who said, "The harvest is great but the labourers are few. Pray that the Lord of the harvest will send labourers into His harvest". (Matthew 9: 37-38). In our Baptism each is called to follow Jesus. At present in the rich countries, there is a significant decrease in the numbers answering the call to priesthood. It is the same in Ireland.

Today as we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday let us strive to be united with Him and his Father, so that we may recognise His voice ina world where there are many voices drawing us away from Him. May the youth have the courage to listen to the voice of the Lord, the Good Shepherd, when He calls them. We can say this prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ, Saviour of the world, may we spend our lives faithful to You. May the Holy Spirit guide priests and all who preach the gospel, and may the Lord of the harvest send labourers into His harvest. Amen
