Parish Accounts 2018

The statement of parish accounts for 2018 shows the continued generosity of the people of the parish to the support of our faith community. We thank you for your support in the upkeep of parish properties and the administration of our parish. 2018 shows a deficit partially due to the carry over of bills from 2017 repair works. The re-surfacing of St. Brendan's church grounds is a planned project for 2020.

In 2018, parishioners contributed €51.805 towards the Priests' Collections of which €19.252 was forwarded to the Diocesan Priest Central Fund ensuring all priests of the diocese receive an equivalent annual remuneration.

There were no claims for Income Tax rebate in 2018 due to a change in our system of recording donations. The new envelope system is vital in our eligibility to receive tax rebates from Inland Revenue. We now keep records of all identifiable contributions. While we very much appreciate the generosity of parishioners who contribute to the basket without using the envelope we are unable to receive tax rebate from these contributions. A special
