Aontacht na gCríostaithe.

Leagann na hEaglaisí Críostaí ar fud an domhain seachtain ar leith amach ó 18 - 25 Eanáir chun guí ar son Aontacht na **críostaithe**. Is é an téama do 2020 ná "d'Fhaltaigh siad romhainn uile" (Gníomhartha 28:2). Guímis mar a dúirt Críost an oíche roimh a bhás, "lonas go mba aon iad go léir, faoi mar atá tusa a Athair ionamsa agus mise ionatsa, go mbeidís seo ina n-aon ionainn i dtreo go gcreidfidh an saol gur chuir tú uait mé" (Eoin17:21). Tharla dhá-mhór-scoilt in Eaglais Chríost. Sa bhliain 1054 scar Eaglais an Oirthir I gConstaninople ón Eaglais sa Róimh agus thug siad Ceartchreidmhaigh orthu féin. Tharla scoilt san Eoraip san séú haois déag agus is as sin a d'fhás na hEaglaisí Protastúnach mar atá an Eaglais Liútarach, an Eaglais Chailvíneach agus an Eaglais Anglacánach. Le breis is céad bliain anuas tá na heaglaisí ag iarraidh na scoilteanna a leigheas. Tugtar Éacúiméineachas ar an iarracht sin. larrtar orainn quí ar son aontacht idir Críostaithe ionas go gcomhlíonfar misean Chríost. Is paidir ar son Aontachta Críostaí í seo:

The week of prayer for Christian Unity is kept throughout the world each year from 18-25 January. The theme for 2020 is: "They Showed Us Unusual Kindness" (Acts 28:2). We are obliged to pray for unity among Christians so that the mission of Christ will be fulfilled. Let us pray as Jesus asked us on the night before He died, "May they all be one. Father, may they be one in us, as you are in me, and I am in you so the world may believe it was you who sent me" (John 17:21). Two major splits occurred in the Church of Christ. In 1014 the Eastern Church in Constantinople separated from the Church in Rome and became the Orthodox Church. In the sixteenth century in Europe there was a split and the Protestant Churches. Lutheran, Calvinistic and Anglican were established. For over a century the unity of the churches is sought. This is called Ecumenism. The following is a prayer for Church Unity:

Father of love you have called us to confraternity with your Son and to be witnesses to the gospel.

Through the grace of the Holy Spirit enable us to overcome divisions and remain steadfast that our joy may be complete.

We ask this through Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.
