This is the 1500th Anniversary of Columba's birth in Donegal. Tradition tells us that he was tall and red- haired with a wonderful singing voice. He was born in Gartan to Felim and Eithne of the Úi Néill royal family and was a possible future high king. He left the life and future that was expected of him to become one of the great missionaries of the early Irish church. His spirit has touched every part of Ireland, Derry, Durrow, Clonnard, Kells, Swords, Longford, Moone and Glen- columcille.	
A famous dispute over copyright resulted in Columba going into exile in Scotland where he established the great monastery of Iona whose influence impacted Scotland and England, The great copy of the Gospels, "The Book of Kells", was produced in its scriptorium.	
Columba was multi-talented, he was a poet, prophet and inspirational leader. The Monastery of Iona contin- ues to our time. A new community of lay people live and work in its ancient buildings and continue to have an outreach to the wider world.
