Third Sunday of Advent

Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, Rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. (Phil 4: 4-5). Today is Gaudete or Rejoicing Sunday; the Third Sunday of Advent when rose coloured vestments replace the purple of repentance and the rose coloured candle is lighting on the Advent Wreath. Our ancestors' custom was to erect the Crib after 8 December. We can say the following prayer in preparation for the great Feast.

Hail and blessed be the hour and moment in which the Son of God was born, of the most pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in the piercing cold. I beseech Thee, O my God, to hear my prayer and grant my petition through the intercession of Jesushrist and the Virgin Mary His Mother. Amen. Gaudate!
